

All Saints Name and Uniforms

All Saints Regional Catholic School was originally named All Saints Academy but by the day of ground breaking on May 16, 1997, it was changed to All Saints Regional Catholic School. The diocese and Bishop Reiss wanted to ensure that the new school would be open to all children as much as that would be possible.

The uniforms were selected after Sr. Jeannette, who was on her way to meet Fr. Ken, became lost. She stopped at the Indian Plaza and asked about the name. The ties to the Native American history of the area helped her decide on earth colors: **hunter green**, **burgundy**, and **khaki**.
